Boiler Replacement Funding Update

Envelopes for the Boiler Replacement are available at the back of the church and can be used to make a donation, or to record a three year pledge. Place envelopes in the collection plate, or leave in slot #19 for Cathy Bird.

We are making good progress towards our target to secure \$111,000 of interest free loans and early donations, in addition to the \$67,000 remaining from the 2010/2011 chancel renewal and capital maintenance campaign. Total loans and donations in hand stand at approximately \$95,000 including a wonderful contribution of \$8,500 from the ACW. We need another \$16,000 in the next few weeks to reach the immediate objective; then we'll need to start building three-year pledges sufficient to repay the temporary loans.

Malcolm McKay will be available in Cormack Hall following the 10 am service with promissory note forms for anyone who wishes to assist with a temporary loan, or to answer any questions.
